EPISTLE -- 1 Corinthians 8:8-9:2

Brethren, food will not commend us to God. We are no worse off if we do not eat, and no better off if we do. Only take care, lest this liberty of yours somehow become a stumbling block to the weak. Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry and feed Thee, or thirsty and give Thee drink? And when did we see Thee a stranger and welcome Thee, or naked and clothe Thee? And when did we see Thee sick or in prison and visit Thee?' And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.' Then He will say to those at his left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave Me no food, I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome Me, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.' Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to Thee?' Then He will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to Me.' And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

The Triodion Sundays Sunday of Judgement (Meatfare Sunday) (Matthew 25:31-46)

On this Sunday, we read the Gospel of Judgment, just as Jesus Christ describes His Second Coming in the Gospel of Matthew. He compares the humans whom He created to cattle, because the image of the shepherd is common about God in the Old Testament, and it is also a common image of priests (see the prophecies of Isaiah, Jeremiah and Ezekiel 34:11).

In the New Testament, Christ likens himself to the Shepherd, knowing that it is also the Lamb that takes away the sin of the world. Since He suffered for our sake, only His love can judge the ingratitude of the world.

This gospel on Meatfare Sunday is meant to make us realize the importance of true love towards others because our neighbor is the Lord Jesus Christ Himself; it is as we are standing before Him.

One is his own judge; all his actions are revealed plainly before God's righteous judgment.

St Jerome (4th century) says: Remember Christ each time you stretch your hand to give... The true temple of Christ is the believer's soul; adorn this, clothe it, offer gifts to it, welcome Christ in it. What use are walls blazing with jewels when Christ in His poor Matthew 25:40 is in danger of perishing from hunger?

St Cyprian of Carthage highlights the importance of adhering to Christ with all our life, says: "But it may be, dearest brethren, that Christ himself is the kingdom of God, for whose coming we daily ask. For since He is our resurrection since in him we rise again, so also the kingdom of God may be understood to be himself since it is in him that we shall reign".

10:00 AM - 11:30 AM


Warrior Women is a personal violence prevention class that teaches women & girls (age 14 & up) techniques to limit potentially dangerous situations.

Update: Scam Text Messages Notice

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Michael's Orthodox Church,

I wanted to update you on what we discovered regarding the scam text and emails that were received by many of you on February 19, 2025. We discovered what happened, which was an **initial scam** that enabled the scammer to gain access to a 2023 copy of the Church Directory. This was deceptive in nature by the scammer who misrepresented themselves as a parishioner. I want to be clear...our new database was NOT hacked... neither were our office computers. You can continue to trust our Realm database system which has professional cybersecurity protocols managed by the parent company ACS Technologies. Again, our database was not hacked, neither were our office computers.

The information that was gained from the directory was the same kind of information that anyone can look up for free on the Internet (name, address, telephone, email, date of birth). What is unique is that the scammer had a list of names of people who might trust me (Fr David) when asked for *financial help.* The person was hoping that someone would think it was me asking them to buy Apple gift cards that I could use to help another parishioner. This was a scam! As I have expressed before, I will never ask a parishioner for financial help via text message or email. Never. So, if you ever get a message like this in the future you can be confident that it is not from me (Fr David) and should not be responded to. If this happens, please contact me right away to verify before doing anything.

An Incident Report was filed with the South Greensburg Police regarding the scam to gain access to an old directory, and the scam texts / emails misrepresenting themselves as Fr. David. While many of our parishioners were disturbed by these texts/emails, which we regret, we are not aware at this time of anyone who sent the scammers any money. The Parish Council was briefed on this at our meeting last night.

Again, we apologize for the inconvenience and concern caused by this incident. May God grant us peace of mind and loving embrace of one another as we enter the upcoming Great Fast.
